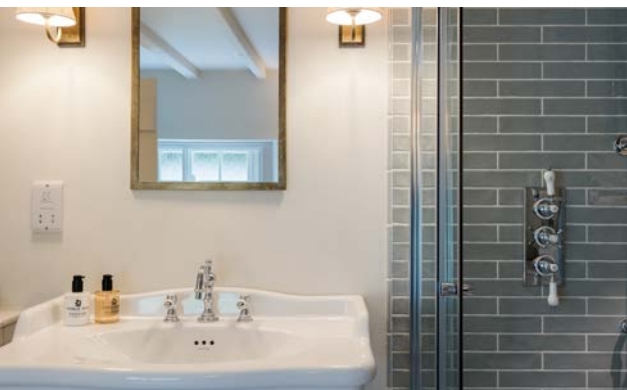

When it comes to things to do, Richmond is the local market town, with one of the best-preserved Norman castles in the country. There are lovely walks on the old railway line along the river Swale to Easby Abbey, and you can grab an ice cream at the old station (which also houses a cinema).



THINGS TO DO CONTINUED

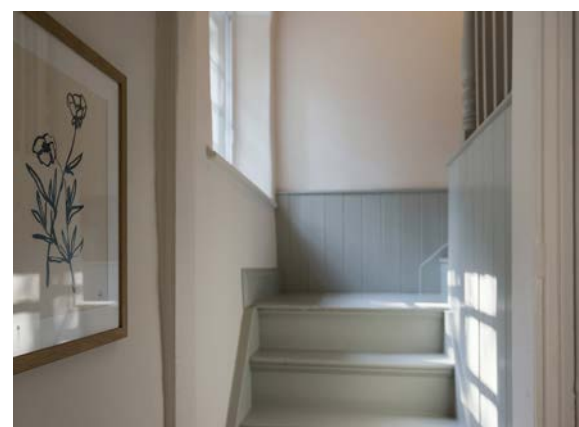
Leyburn is another pretty market town - with lovely antique shops and cafes - and for the more serious antique lover check out the auctions at Tennants.

From there, you could head up to Hawes and nearby Wensleydale (famous for their cheese).

For walks we'd recommend Reeth, Gunnerside & Arkengarthdale, with views across the hills and down dales, a proper pub for a pint afterwards and there is fantastic ice cream in Reeth. If you have your bike with you there are excellent off road tracks around Reeth, or Tour de Yorkshire worthy hill climbs between Swaledale and Wensleydale.
